

SoFi Alcohol Policy

Purpose

- To assist Bartenders, and other employees in preventing and reducing problems associated with alcohol use, and to create a safe environment for our patrons.
- To assist Bartenders, and other employees to prepare and serve standard drinks according to industry requirements.
- To encourage customers courteously and diplomatically to drink within appropriate limits. To recognize erratic drinking patterns as an early sign of possible intoxication and taking appropriate action.

Compliance

- You must I.D. everyone, each, and every time.
- You can only serve 2 alcoholic beverages per person, per transaction, per ID.

Example: A guest cannot have more than 2 Alcoholic beverages in their hands.

Example: If you sell a bottle of Wine, you must have at least 2 Person's ID and 4 glasses are to be given.

- Every canned beverage must be opened before handing it to the guest.
- NO EFT TIPS ALLOWED.
- NO CASH TIPS ALLOWED.
- NO CASH SALES ALLOWED.
- No Shots! All Cocktails must be served with ICE CUBES.
- Minors in possession of alcohol, or any person that furnishes alcohol, or causes alcohol to be furnished to a person under 21 years of age is guilty of a misdemeanor, subject to a \$1000 fine, or imprisonment and will be ejected from the venue. (Section 25658 CA B&P Code)
- You may not serve anyone who appears to be impaired.
- NO MARRYING OF ALCOHOLIC BOTTLES – It is prohibited to combine contents from one bottle into another.
- Alcohol sales will stop at the end of the 3rd Quarter, at all concessions locations. {Exception of location that will serve up to 45 minutes after the game. Notification of management.)
- Exception: Inclusive Clubs will stop service at the end of the game or start of the main act during a Concert Event.)
- No free pouring allowed. Bartenders must use a 1.5 oz Jigger.
- You must be state trained, (**RBS**), and have a current certification on file.

Scope

- To give responsible service of the establishment and its employees to provide a safe space in which patrons can partake in alcohol.

Procedures

- Before serving alcohol beverages to customers ensure that the Alcohol Policy has been reviewed.
 - Ensure that you have a 1.5 oz Jigger.
 - Ensure you have a clear understanding of the location standards of your assigned area.

Enforcement

- A violation of this policy may result in disciplinary action up to and including removal from the venue and future ability to provide service at the venue.
