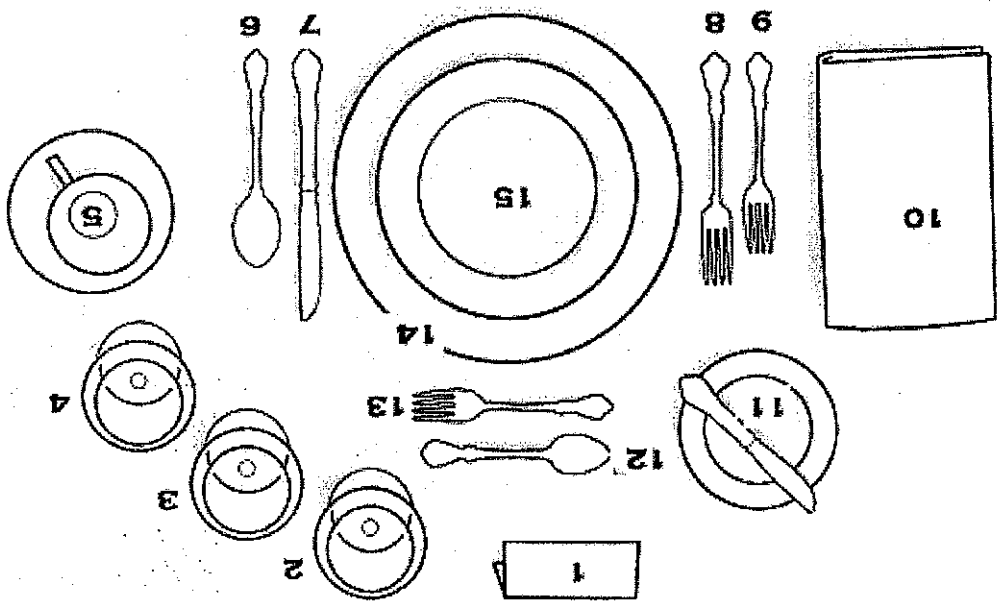
Tray Jack
