Sewing Machine Operator

- Monitored machine operation to detect problems such as defective stitching, breaks in thread, or machine malfunctions.
- Positioned items under needles, using marks on machines, clamps, templates, or cloth as guides.
- Placed spools of thread, cord, or other materials on spindles, insert bobbins, and thread ends through machine guides and components.
- Matched cloth pieces in correct sequences prior to sewing them, and verify that dye lots and patterns match.
- Guided garments or garment parts under machine needles and presser feet to sew parts together.
- Started and operated or tend machines, such as single or double needle serging and flat-bed felling machines, to automatically join, reinforce, or decorate material or articles.
- Recorded quantities of materials processed.
- Inspected garments, and examine repair tags and markings on garments to locate defects or damage, and mark errors as necessary.
- Selected supplies such as fasteners and thread, according to job requirements.
- Mounted attachments, such as needles, cutting blades, or pattern plates, and adjust machine guides according to specifications.
- Cut excess material or thread from finished products.
- Folded or stretched edges or lengths of items while sewing to facilitate forming specified sections.
- Performed equipment maintenance tasks such as replacing needles, sanding rough areas of needles, or cleaning and oiling sewing machines.
- Examined and measured finished articles to verify conformance to standards, using rulers.

- Built containment areas prior to beginning abatement or decontamination work. Green Task Statement
- Removed asbestos or lead from surfaces, using hand or power tools such as scrapers, vacuums, or high-pressure sprayers. Green Task Statement
- Identified asbestos, lead, or other hazardous materials to be removed, using monitoring devices. Green Task Statement

- Recorded numbers of containers stored at disposal sites, specifying amounts or types of equipment or waste disposed. Green Task Statement
- Sorted specialized hazardous waste at landfills or disposal centers, following proper disposal procedures. Green Task Statement
- Operated cranes to move or load baskets, casks, or canisters. Green Task Statement
- Drove trucks or other heavy equipment to convey contaminated waste to designated sea or ground locations.
